Information on the European Commission investigation

Focus Home Interactive confirms it received a statement of objections from the European Commission in the context of the investigation opened on 2 February 2017¹ into agreements entered into between Valve Corporation, owner of the games distribution platform Steam, and five video games publishers, including Focus Home Interactive. A statement of objections informs the recipient that the EU believes antitrust rules may have been breached and enables it to set out its observations. The sending of a statement of objections does not prejudice the outcome of the investigation.

This statement of objections was communicated by the European Commission in a press release published today at 11.45am CEST².

Focus Home Interactive takes due note of this statement and will continue to cooperate with the Commission.
